Description: Polychrome cross-stitch on dark blue cotton. A) is unhemmed; 2 floral rinceau bands over one butterfly; green, magenta, white, orange, purple, and blue. B) (CS: Pocket evidently made out of the end of a girdle) is sewn together, embroidered both at front and reverse side; at top bound with green and magenta stitches; one band of tassels; one band of rinceau with pairs of birds and pomegranates, one band of floral rinceau; various shades of green, pink, and yellow.
