Vari-colored cotton appliqué animal (CS: guardian spirit) on back. Animal has attributes of a 'frog' and of a 'lion' (CS: backbone) and has a flower leading from tail. Colors in appliqué include off-white, dark & light blue, red, gray, violet, maroon & pink; some prints. (CS: Obviously had been worn).

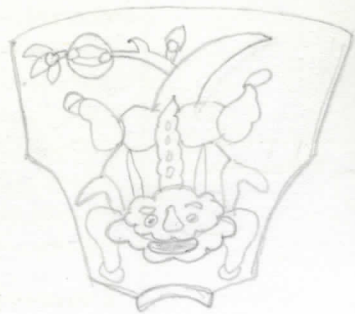
