The small end of such a net is attached to the waist of the fisherman and the net is then thrown, with a full arm movement, so that it spreads and falls like a parachute. The sinkers strike the water at the same instant and the fish within the circle dart inward to escape them. When the weights have reached the bottom the operator draws them toward him until, when they are directly below, their weight closes the net and makes captive all the fish within.
