An recent years many metal poto have reached the Glongot through trade. However, some of the women ard stell excellent potters. They knead the elay with their hands, in order to semove gravel and lumps, and then shape the pole with Their hands. A portion of a broken dish generally serves as a crude pollers wheel and is turned with the hands. The final shaping is done with wooden puddles in which designs have been cut. When these are pressed against the damp clay they leave a decorative impoint. The pole are then fired and are ready for use.
