Material: Wood, steel, bronze, leather

Description:

- A. Knife, lanceolate leaf shaped, single edge, slightly convexed at back side, broadly convexed at sharp side, converging to sharp point. Bronze band at base of hilt which is recurved.
- B. Sheath of plain dark wood, slightly tapered at base, projecting out and down at hilt end (one projection broken), short leather guard on one side.

Dimensions: Blade: 43 L, 7 W. Hilt: 18 L. Band 2.2
