Object: Knife and sheath.

Material: Steel, wood, horn.

## Description:

- A. Knife, single convex edge, curving to sharp point with straight dorsal side. At proximal end, blade reduces abruptly in width from 3.2 cm to about 1.7 cm and increases in thickness from sharp to 1 cm. Wood handle 10 cm L. Semi-circular horn guard, 2 cm W extends toward cutting edge.
- B. Sheath of split wood, bronze (corroded) tip, 2.7 cm bronze band at mid-section. Wire bound at proximal end.
- Dimensions: Blade: 24. Handle 11 Shaped to fit knife but  
(in cm.) Sheath: 27 no guard protection.
