Name Knife and sheath (itan). Iron blade and handle. Flat, curved edged blade tapering to handle. Handle bound with brass, wire and strips of cordage. Thin brass disk hand guard. Sheath of two thin flat pieces of light wood partly covered with palm leaf and strips of rattan.

Curved, flaring end. Cordage waist string.

Probably made at Kāg or Pāgi. Heel of blade with 4 triangular perforations. Sheath of wood called bĒtak; body wrapped in bark from base of betel branches and coiled with bejuca.
