Description: <sup>A-</sup>Kris, steel blade, incised with linear floral patterns. Tip damaged. Handle, carved wood, butt carved and incised. Bound with alternating bands of brass and cord. <sup>B-</sup>Scabbard: two wooden pieces held together by plaited rattan, front side in brown and natural, rear side in natural color.
