Object: Sword and scabbard

Material: Metal, wood, vegetable fiber.

Description: A- Sword with kris type blade of moderate wave extending  $1/2$  the length of the blade. Damascening at top in a line and flower design, which is corroded green. Guard of cutout type with one side wider than the other. Hilt is of alternating bands of braided wire and plain metal. Pommel is 8 faceted with flat top. There are two reinforcing bands of metal on guard. B- Scabbard is a plain light colored wood, of the split type held together with twine. See reverse for photo.
