**Description:** Silver coin reused as a toggle. Yunnan provincial dollar, reign of Kuang-Hsu (1875-1908); obverse, imperial Manchu dragon coiled around a flaming pearl, surrounded by plain circular border; inscription all on back, where a soldered wire loop holds a silver ring for the cord. Acquired in Jade Market, Peking, late 1920's, early 1930's.
