② COMMENT BY MR. DUBOSE, JAN. 1938:- LIKED THE DRAWING OF THE  
BAMBOO BUT FOUND THE ROCK VERY CARELESS AND QUITE OUT OF KEEPINGS.  
HE DID NOT EXAMINE THE REST. (WILDUR)

③ INJ. CAMILL: He was one of the '8 YANGCHOW ECCENTRICS'  
famous for ARCHAIAC SCRIPT STYLES - stone cut inscriptions

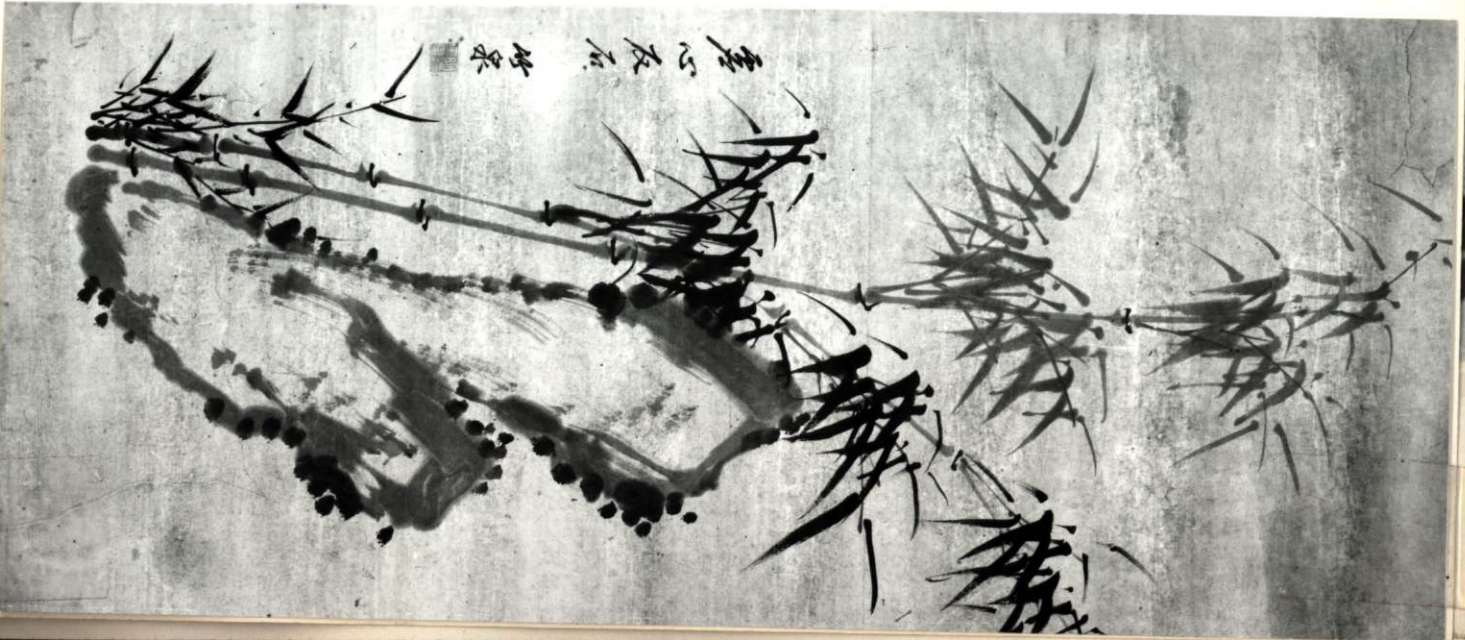
