Description: Bristles bound at base with several rows of sinew-like string and attached to a wooden handle covered with a black lacquered cloth decorated with red and gold dragon in clouds, flowers, leaves, birds and waves. Gold Greek fret at either end of handle. Ivory ring fitted at tip of handle. Strip of lacquered cloth at brush end of handle repaired with glue. Brush to be placed in wooden stand, Cat. No. 235169.

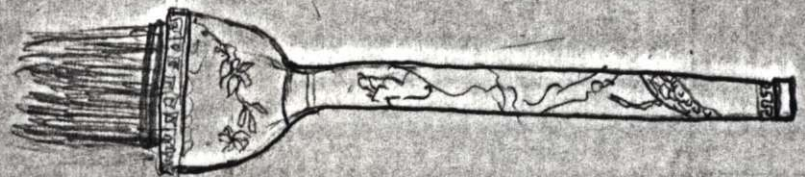
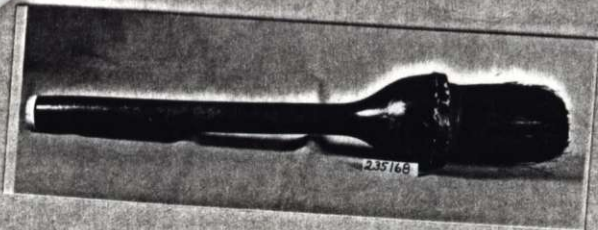
