

BREECH CLOTHS.

There are several varieties of breech cloths in common use. The simplest, of ~~flayed tree bark~~, is made by the women of Barlig, Talubin, Agawa, and neighboring villages. Others are made of tree cotton, while many are woven from trade materials. A considerable number of cloths are now secured ready-made from the coast. A large proportion of the men in Bontoc and Samoki use the cloths simply as aprons, suspended from the girdles.
