## COPPER GONGS (Gansa)

Music for the typical dance is produced by three gansas and a drum. The gansas are pressed against the thighs of the players who kneel on the ground. Two of the coppers are beaten with a stick and the palm of the hand, while the third is played with the hands alone.

The gongs doubtless came into this region through trade, but at a time so remote that their origin is now credited to the spirits.
