

# **POLISHED BRONZE SLAB**

Used as a mirror. Made of speculum metal, an alloy of copper and tin, a variety of bronze. The Roman speculum usually contained from 65 to 70 per cent of copper. An analysis of this specimen shows 67 per cent copper, 31 per cent tin, and no lead.
