

# ARRETINE POTTERY

The manufacturing center of this ware was in the town of Arretium, modern Arezzo, in northern Italy. This pottery is decorated in relief with figures and designs of Hellenistic style, and was made in molds. The flourishing period of the Arretine pottery industry was in the century between 40 B. C. and A. D. 60.
