BLOWGUNS AND DARTS

Blowguns are made of reeds on the same principle as "bean-blowers." In this district the projectiles are small bamboo darts to which tufts of cotton are attached. So far as is known the Bagobo do not poison these weapons. Blinds are often built in trees frequented by birds, and hunters are thus able to approach near enough to make the guns effective. Used only for hunting and chiefly by boys.
