

MEN'S BAGS

The suits of the Bagobo men contain no pockets; so carrying bags, which hang on the back, are used to supply the deficiency. These are supported by means of bands which slip over each shoulder. Hemp cloth is used for the bag proper, but over this are elaborate designs in beads and shell disks. The bells are all cast by native artisans.
