

# MARBLE BURIAL URN

On the cover is a reclining obese man, indicating that the ashes deposited in the receptacle were those of a man. The relief on the front of the receptacle represents a mounted man, the bridle of whose horse is grasped by a winged demon. Behind the horseman is an armed esquire, and behind the latter is a winged female demon. The scene probably signifies the journey of the deceased to the nether world. There are considerable remains of color on the relief and slight traces on the cover.
