Description: Dark blue cross-stitch, satin-stitch, and variety stitches on off-white cotton. Hem: 3 sides. Satin-stitch zig-zag-design. Border: 3 sides. Cartouches with floral and faunal design. Butterflies at the lower corners. Field: Scrolls for corner triangles. Flowers and insects. Central bird; hare. No medallions. A casing made of thinner off-white cotton is applied across the top, and extends one inch beyond each side of the piece. Some holes on casing and curtain. CS: Dimensions: the bed curtain was hung by the casing (in cm.) 178 x 41 on the top of the bed-frame.
