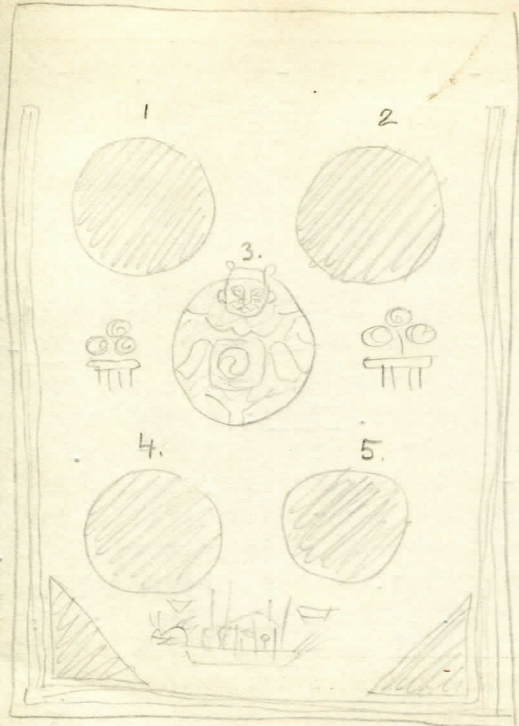

Field: 2 lower corner triangles; floral, butterfly and angular scrolls. Between these one dragon-boat with 6 travellers and 2 smaller boats above. 5 medallions; central medallion flanked by 2 fruit-and flower-trees in pots on tables. Med.1 and 2 (from top) floral. 2) has a central lotus; Dimensions: (in cm.) 1) holds a bat. Central medallion 3): (CS: 189x77 "Ho-ch'i-t'uan" or "lo ha(n)'r") A man with
