Object: Metal pointed arrow, with blade sheath.

Material: Bamboo, feathers, metal, wood.

Description: A-shaft made of bamboo; the lanceolate point is of metal; the butt has three kalow bird feathers lashed to the shaft.

B-blade sheath carved of wood, in two sections with one piece broken off. Four bands of painted cloth hold the sheath together

Note: points are made from broken knives or from pieces of lowland truck springs.
