Description: Blue-dyed white cotton bed-spread made of 4 parallel strips of fabric sewn together. At one side, some frogs. Design: All-over pattern of 8-petalled rosettes; tiedye; along sides, rows of smaller tie-dyed rosettes; at top and bottom ends, bands of white and some white zig-zag, perhaps sew-dye. Repaired by one patch at the center; other patches near edge.
