Border: 2 sides, floral rinceau, different at each side; pink, magenta and mostly blue. Field: 4 corner triangles with pairs of fruit or flowers; magenta, pink, and mostly blue. Central medallion: (CS: Worship of the white snake) 7 human figures, snake, pagoda, altar, and bird. Mostly blue; polychrome details. Some stains. One red cord at one side.
