Tobacco is constantly smoked from earliest youth by both sexes in the Gran Chaco and Matto Grosso regions. A native variety of tobacco is cultivated and smoked in pipes. The latter generally consist of a wooden bowl into which a stem of cactus wood is inserted. The bowls vary very greatly in shape, but there seems to be no tribal type in any group.
