- 1. This papyrus is written in Demotic of the late Ptolemaic period and is dated at about 107 B.C.
- 2. It comes from Thebes, Egypt (Western Necropolis)
- of a promissory note of a herdsman of Thebes to a woman, and states the terms under which he will repay her debt. On the back are 14 signatures of witnesses, also signed by a notary.
- 4. Date is exactly year 9th of Cleopatra and Ptolemy Philometor Soter (Ptolemy X Soter II). Month and day once given but now lacking. May be 106 or 107 B.C.
