Name Blow-gun (Sumpitan) made of rujung (outer layer of the anau sugar palm arenga sacchari fera labell). Has been covered with bladder pieces or intestines but this nearly gone. Darts usually used are Palasu of the stiff fibers found at base of leaf stalks of the anau sharpened. Reed pith at other end. Used for killing birds and fish, not as a weapon. Small clay pellets also used.
