Lei of four bands of Vini kuhli feathers interspersed with iwi (?) feathers alternating with 4 apapane bands each having a few tufts of 'O'O and a few Vini kuhli feathers. Tied on the Vini kuhli end with cotton string is a tie of four lengths of dark yellow yarn. Other end has black silk velvet ribbon tie. 'O'O were endemic to Hawaiian Islands.
