Description: Lengthwise half of narrow-necked gourd with leather loop 4 cm. long inserted at base. Inside cream, undecorated; outside tan with black incised decoration. 9 cm. flower in center with one human and 2 insect or animal forms on either side, separated from border on either side by 2 snakes. Border 4 cm. wide on bowl, continuing and narrowing on stem; border on one side consists of diagonal stripes and scallops; on other side, diamond stripes and shaded band. By Peter Nzuki.
