Longitudinal fracture almost bisecting lip and lower half of tongue on one surface while similar fault ^{See reverse}

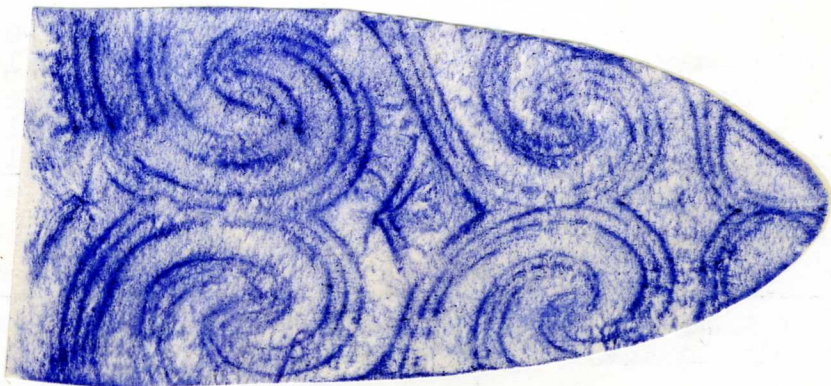
