Detailed description: Missile club of hard dark brown wood. Grip is finely incised. Rows of punctate marks on the shaft between the grip and the knob. Knob is domed (dome has lost its original ivory inlay. The "wheel" or flanged portion of the head has 10 crudely-shaped, relatively circular ^{See reverse}
