Detailed description: Billet club of wood; cylindrical in section; completely carved shaft tapers from domed but rather pointed distal end to splayed proximal end; massive lug at the proximal end perforated by a biconical hole that is angled into shaft, i.e., the lug is undercut by the perforation.
