Description: the stem end of the bowl runs into the body at a 45° angle; the body of the bowl opens into three flaring mouths (these were formerly connected to each other by a bridge which has been broken off; the body of the bowl is covered by horizontal ranks of conical protruberances; black slip with red and white pigments applied to the surface.
