hide.Description: A—Semi-ovoid clay bowl covered with hide;
stem perpendicular to bowl; rings of different metals
around stem; 2 scraping implements on chain of large
links attached to rings of stem. Man's pipe.B—As above; bowl shorter, rounder, only copper rings
around stem; 1 iron scraper on chain of small links;
iron mouthpiece. Woman's pipe.
