Additional ornamentation occurs at tip of "snout" where there is a large cluster of cassowary feathers, some nut rattles, and a lengtheof dirty red cotton cloth. Several tufts of red yarn are drawn and knotted through small holes in the mouth end of the drum. Additional incised area is at head-end. It is filled with white and red pigment. Much red pigment around depressed area where head fits. Red yarn tuft at this end also. An old ms label is affixed and reads: "A Drum from the Iland /sic/ of New Guinea". Two additional lines are illegible. Inside of mouth is painted red.
