

# 5. LI T'IE-K'WAI.

Li with the iron staff or crutch on which he leans and sets his left foot. He usually carries a gourd in which his blessings are stored, and is represented as a beggar. A peach cut out of pewter, surrounded by two cranes of brass, is attached to the candlestick. Both peach and crane are emblems of longevity.
