

# PAIR OF OIL-LAMPS.

Two saddled deer with tribute vases on back and fungus of immortality in mouths. Deer is of species *Cervus mandarinus*, called *mei hua lu* ("plum-blossom stag") and hence represented with plum-blossoms on its skin. Inscriptions in front of pedestals, yielding date 1900.
