Description: hat has high, peaked crown, wide flat brim made from layers of wide strips of fiber drawn from brim into peak, fibers sewn together. Brim edged with a strip of fiber running perpendicular to brim fibers around the hat. Topped with strips of fiber arranged in a cross sewn over peak. Worn by both sexes.

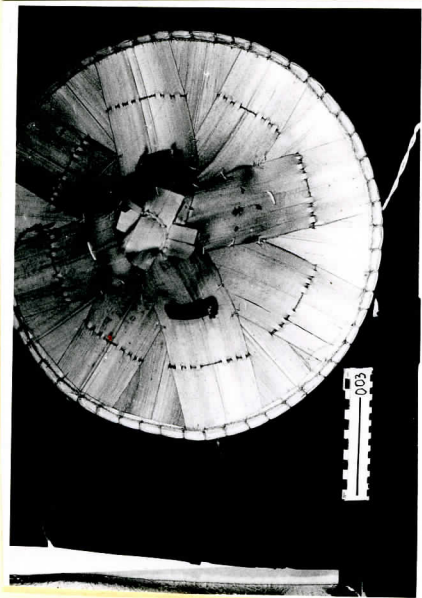
