Machine-made chain-stitch embroidery in white synthetic floss: wave-like pattern around sleeve hems; filigree pattern around neck; elaborate scrolled pattern at center front.

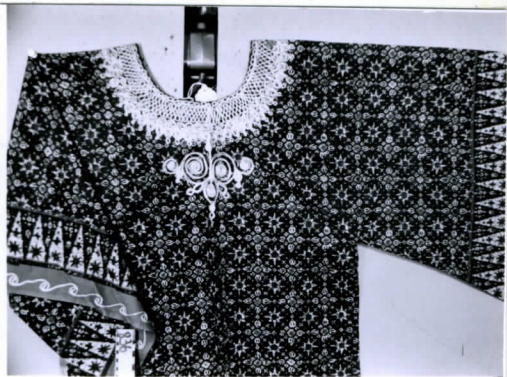
