Description: Robe is made from 23 strips, each 10 cm wide, sewn together with green cotton thread. Pattern of each strip includes finely-woven blocks striped longitudinally in three shades of green and heavily-woven blocks with a variety of geometric patterns in maroon, black, bright green, gold color, and white. Each end has short fringe. Handwoven for a chief.


