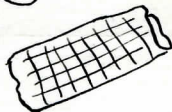

3. Piece of dark brown cloth
4. sharp little ^{black} horn container - with medicine
10.3 cm long
5. stone celt 7.4 X 4.7 X 1.2
6. stone object with scored lines
9.6 X 4.2 X 1.4



7. string bag or pouch with blue, green, yellow and black beads.
