Object: Pouch on bead necklace; used in the ritual of Ifa divination.

Material: European cloth, native cloth, string, diverse types of beads, seeds.

Description: Cloth pouch with flap; embroidered with strings of beads making a pattern of lozenges of different colors; carrying string made of strands of small beads of different kinds passing through large ovoid beads; each composite link is made of different kinds of beads, contrasting with the elements preceding and succeeding.
