Description: Long cylindrical drum truncated at both ends one end covered with an animal skin. Kept taut by means of oblique pegs inserted into the upper part of the drum. Under this a wide band of undulating gauged cuts; Under this a band of 7 mens heads with long braided beards which extend downward past the midline of the drum meeting a wide band of framed oblongs. Uner neath this a wide band of quatre foil incised ornaments standing three units deep. Under

this a row of heads in high relief, without beards.
