Name Woman's girdle, formed of 16 strings of beads (blue, white and a few pink) fastened at ends to strips of leather (rhino hide) which can be laced together with leather string. The strings are also passed through 2 other strips of leather to keep them in position. Some cowrie shells fastened to lower string.
