Material: Beadwork, sisal, copper and silver colored chain

Description: Apron is worn by older unmarried girls when out walking or at dances. Usually sold to younger girls at marriage. A rectangle of close beadwork in small geometric designs in light and dark blue, green, yellow and red on a white ground. Short loops of silver colored chain hang from the middle bottom with copper chain loops at each side. A twisted sisal string ties around the waist.

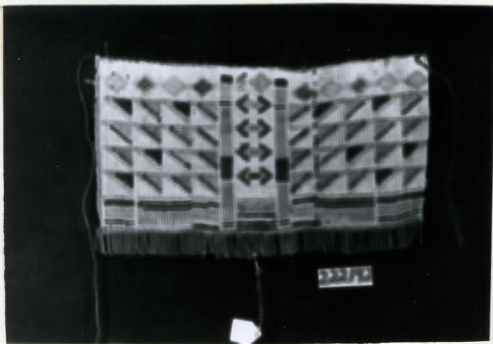
