Description: Married woman's apron is made of an oblong piece of heavy leather tied around the waist with a leather thong. Mostly white, blue and red 5 mm. glass beads are sewn closely in horizontal strings of 9-11 beads each on two plaques which are sewn vertically to the apron. Metal beads (aluminum and iron) are sewn in a double row along the slightly incurved sides.
