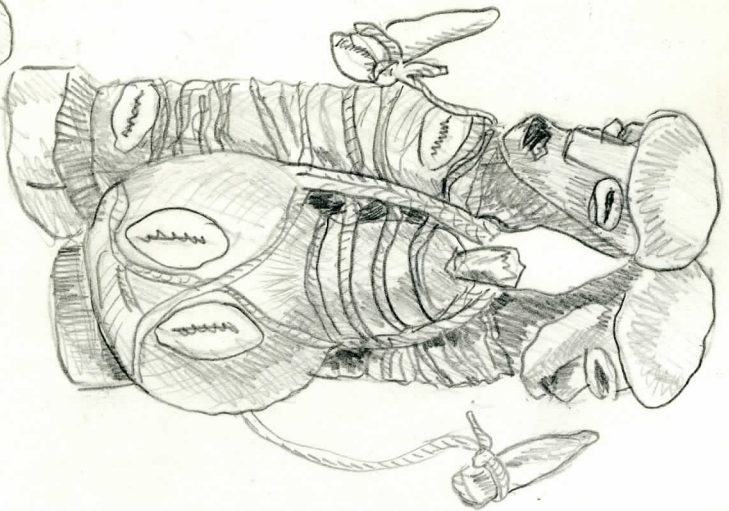

Two cowrie shells embedded in each of the 2 "gourds", 2 other cowries on the fronts of the figures. Four wooden cones are attached to the ensemble, permitting insertion into holes in the mouth of one figure, the left side of the head of the other figure, and into the tops of each of the two "gourds".</p> </div>
