Material: Metal, glass, cotton.

Description: 3 strands red glass beads strung on black thread, a fourth attached row is of brass rings with brass pendants on alternate rings. Pattern is 3 short pendants, 1 long, 2 short continuing until final 3 short ones; pendants consist of coils, rings, and serrated disks and keystones of shell. Ends of strands are finished with cotton threads knotted to form end attachments. Age = late 19th cen. Owner = Simpuda
