Material: wood, gourd, leather, cord, glass beads

Description: A: wine goblet top has a strand of beads wrapped several times around its narrow neck, tied with a dangling cord. Bead colors are yellow, red, two white, green, blue, two red, orange, and black. B: Fat container made from bulbous gourd has narrow leather neck. 4 leather straps surround gourd as a sling, and braided leather handle is tied to straps. Container has decorative whorl of beads in blue, red, white, and green.
