**Description:** A and B- both have thongs between the toes which ends in a knot, one wider flat piece of leather wrapped around thong to make side straps for sandal, and several thicknesses of leather for sole. Browns, green, yellow, white are the colours of leather. Geometric designs have been stained on and narrow twisted leather strips have been applied for decoration.
